There was a large and enthusiastic audience at Eileen Ralf's second recital at the City Hall on Tuesday night. The programme, which is a little concession to popular taste, opened with a group of Couperin pieces exquisitely played. Her "Sonata in D Major" (K.576) followed and was Ralf's interpretation of this work with deep feeling and understanding. In her "Sonatina" she brought out all the qualities of this beautiful work and her "Chromatic Fantasy" and "Fugue," with their first half of the programme ended, was a climax.

The second part of the programme consisted of her "Bacchante," a group of Debussy compositions, Bizet-Rachmaninov "Menuet" and Liszt's "Dans Russe." In all of these she presented herself as an artist of sound musician and the highest technical skill. The appreciation of the audience was shown in no uncertain manner and as encores she gave a Brahms Intermezzo and Rachmaninov's "Prelude in B Flat." Ralf's next concert with the Municipal Orchestra, conducted by Thomas Matthews, will be at the City Hall to-morrow (Saturday)
