## Yfrah Neaman.

Yfrah Neaman, the young Palestinian violinist,  
 was accorded a great reception at the City Hall  
 last night for his brilliant playing.

Arrangements have been made for Mr. Neaman  
 to give another concert, and this will take place  
 on Thursday next, 4th July, also at the City  
 Hall, when his programme will include: Sonata in  
 D major (Handel); Concerto in G minor, Op. 26  
 (Max Bruch); Poeme for Violin and Piano, Op.  
 25 (Chausson); "Andaluza" (Granados); "La Fon-  
 taine D'Arethuse" (Szymonowski); "Tambourin  
 Chinois" (Kreisler); "Caprice en Forme de Valse"  
 (Saint-Saens-Ysage). John Pritchard, accompan-  
 ist to Mr. Neaman, will also present piano solos  
 which promise to be of more than ordinary in-  
 terest.

## "Road to Liberty."

"The Road to Liberty" at the Odeon and Cur-  
 zon is a story in brief of the great part the Jewish  
 Brigade played in the war. It opens with glimpses  
 of the Auschwitz horror camp and depicts heart-  
 rending scenes of cruelty and suffering. This is  
 followed by scenes in Palestine where the Jewish  
 Brigade was formed. It shows how great was the  
 enthusiasm of the hundreds of Jewry's youth who  
 made up that all-Jewish unit. Subsequently it  
 was attached to the Eighth Army and its work in  
 Italy is briefly recorded. The film concludes with  
 a service of thanksgiving in Dachau, that notorious  
 camp where thousands of Jews were done to death  
 by the Nazis. A tribute is due to Mr. N. Lourie  
 who gave the commentary.
