Recital by Beatrice Gibson.

The Lieder Recital given by the Natal contralto, Beatrice Gibson at the Hofmeyr Hall on Monday night was an outstanding musical event. While each item on the programme was a gem in itself, the most profound impression was created by Schumann's *Frauenliebe und Leben* (Woman's Love and Life), a cycle of eight songs.
