POSTAL SERVICE TO PALESTINE

The S.A. Zionist Federation wishes to notify the public that letters sent by individuals to Nicosia, Cyprus, for transmission to Israel, have not reached their destination. All letters for Israel should be sent to the S.A. Zionist Federation.

The following rules must be strictly adhered to:—

- 1.—Write the letter in the usual way and put it in an envelope with the address of the person to whom the letter is sent in Palestine. Seal this letter.
- 2.—Put this letter in a second envelope, addressed to Postal Communications, Zionist Federation, Box 18, Johannesburg. Stamp this outer envelope in the usual way.
- 3.—Do not affix stamps to your letters addressed to Palestine.
- 4.—Send 1/-, either in stamps or postal order, with each letter weighing up to half an ounce.
- 5.—Do not use stamped air-letter cards.
- 6.—No money orders, postal orders or any dutiable articles are allowed to be sent.

It is emphasised that no responsibility for the safe delivery of these letters can be accepted by the Zionist Federation, which, however, will do everything in its power to ensure regular communication. At the same time, steps are being taken to maintain incoming letters from Palestine to the Union.
