## The Zionist Congress.

The reports published of the deliberations of the Zionist Congress have been so brief that it would be hardly fair to pass any criticism upon the views expressed until the arrival in the course of the next week or so of the full reports of the various speeches and then, we in South Africa will be able to judge the real facts. But, there are two matters that call for some comment. The first is the decision to form a Jewish Agency. We think that this is indeed a wise one and will lead to all sections of Jewry being invited to take part in the great task of upbuilding Palestine. Unfortunately, in the past there has been a tendency upon the part of extreme Zionists to adopt the wrong tactics in regard to those who are not in sympathy with their aims. Instead of using every tactful method possible, they have published criticisms and denunciations which have not been in the best interests of the Zionist movement. The Jewish Agency, if properly supported, will be the means of bringing about a better understanding between all sections of Jewry no matter whether they be Zionist or not and thus the work will be considerably assisted.

The other incident which calls for some attention is the fact that during the Congress, Dr. Weiz-
