### BOOKS FOR THE TROOPS AT BASES AND IN HOSPITAL

### Thousands More Needed

South African soldiers at bases and in hospitals are clamouring for books to read. Although the Y.M.C.A. and Toc H War Fund Committee have already sent the troops some 36,000 books up to date, these have proved insufficient to satisfy the literary appetites of our young men in the forces.

Arrangements are being made to despatch thousands of additional books. if the public will only supply them. Another great need is for packing cases, which should not be larger than 2ft. x 2ft. x 2ft.

In Johannesburg books can be left at the Public Library, with whom the Y.M.C.A. and Toc H Committee are co-operating, or they will be called for once a week at the homes of people who notify the Library that they have books available for the soldiers. In the country areas donors of books for the troops can rail or post them free to the librarian of the nearest of the following towns: Johannesburg, Pretoria, Capetown, Durban, East London, Port Elizabeth, Maritzburg, Kimberley, Ladysmith and Bloemfontein. Such parcels should not exceed 7lb. and should be marked "Books for the Troops."

THE Military Medal has been awarded to Private A. M. M. Ruda for distinguished service with the British forces in the Italian East African campaign.

The news of his award adds yet another Jewish name to the list of those who have rendered distinguished service in the present struggle for freedom and democracy.
