on the Baltic and from the existence of a German minority.

What of the future? The interest of Jews in South Africa is focussed mainly on Lithuania from which so many of our community here have come and where accordingly many still have close relatives. Reports now to hand show that all Zionist organisations as well as the Palestine office at Kaunas have been closed down and Zionist funds have been prohibited. Perhaps in view of the past history of the Soviet, this was not unexpected. Ever since the Bolsheviks seized power in 1918 they have declared themselves as uncompromisingly hostile to Zionism. That was because, in their view, Zionism was inseparably linked with British imperialism and capitalism. It is most regrettable, however, that that attitude still persists. Zionism has proved itself a great creative force and is a superb example of redemption of abandoned land and of agricultural progressiveness. Surely this must commend itself to Soviet ideology? Moreover, what of the collective farms and co-operative enterprises? Will the Kremlin in its anti-British prejudice, persist in turning the blind spot to these facets of the National Homeland? In 1918 it was necessary for the Soviet to consolidate itself against all movements it considered disruptive of its ultimate object. To-day that need is gone. The Soviet system is entrenched. Then as to Judaism, is it too much to hope that the Jewish people will, consistently with the general Soviet conception of fostering national minorities within its borders, be allowed to develop along their national lines? We have it that celebrations throughout Russia of the eight hundredth anniversary of Jehuda Halevi, the great Hebrew poet and philosopher, took place recently. At the same time it is reported from Kaunas that several Jewish religious bodies and newspapers have been closed down. It is quite impossible to find in the obscure labyrinth of Russian philosophy what path leads out to the future.

## Ort Guardianship Plans Transferred to England.

### CABLE FROM LADY MARLEY

As a result of inquiries received by the South African Ort-Oze as to the use to which the funds raised by the Lady Marley Guardianship Plans will be put for the duration of the war, a cable was despatched to Lady Marley in London. The following reply, dated the 21st July, has been received by the Johannesburg office of the Ort-Oze:—

"For the duration of the war propose to transfer Guardianship scheme for the benefit of boys in existing Ort Technical Schools in England. We are planning to open a similar training school for destitute girl refugees. Assistance for this work urgently needed.—Lady Marley and Ort-Oze Committee."

In view of this cable, it is hoped that all ladies who undertook to subscribe to the Ort Guardianship Scheme when Lady Marley visited this country last year, will continue to pay their instalments regularly.

The South African Ort-Oze is in close touch with the headquarters of the Organisation in England which is now being conducted by Lieut.-Col. J. H. Levey, D.S.O., O.B.E., the Right Hon. Lord Marley, D.S.C., D.L., J.P., and Lady Marley, and an Executive Committee of leading people including Prof. S. Brodetsky, Mr. Neville J. Laski, K.C., Rabbi Dr. I. Mattuck, the Chief Rabbi, the Very Rev. Dr. J. H. Hertz, the Hon. Lily Montagu, J.P., O.B.E., and many others.
