With the purpose of giving ideological direction to the Zionist Youth movement with particular reference to Chalutmovement with particular reference to Chalutziuth, special teachers are being invited to participate in the practical instruction, for example, working in the fields, and giving lectures on Jewish culture, Hebrew, etc.

Ample time will be given for recreation, including tennis and swimming in Balfour Park.

The Chairman of Kfar Balfouria, Mr. Norman Lourie, will be the Rosh Hamachanah, and it is proposed to form a camp committee comprising representatives of each section of the Zionist Youth Movement.

The camp, which will commence about December 20, for two or three weeks, will be open to anyone who has reached the age of 16 years by 1st January, 1944. It is intended to run the camp through the different sections of the Zionist Youth and Habonim Movement and that each section will have the opportunity of concentrating on its portion. tunity of concentrating on its particular curriculum and programme, although many aspects will be operated jointly.




