

## Zionist Youth Activities.

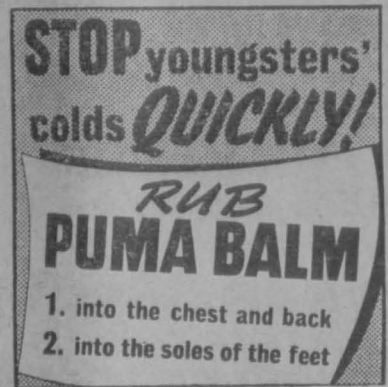
