## ALHAMBRA.

An exciting tribute to the Submarine Service is conveyed in "Close Quarters," a British documentary film which will be released at the Alhambra Theatre next week especially for Navy Week. This will be screened during the first half of the programme to the musical comedy "Reveille with Beverly." Produced by Ian Dalrymple for the Crown Film Unit with the full co-operation of the Admiralty, the film illustrates the log book of one of His Majesty's submarines operating in enemy waters off Norway. It is said to be superbly photographed, and naturally and vigorously portrayed by officers and men of the Submarine Service, and the onlooker virtually lives with the crew of the craft.

## ROYAL.

The story of "Cry Havoc," which opens at the Royal Theatre on Monday, is simple. After the infamous Japanese attack on the never-to-be-forgotten morning of December 7, General MacArthur's forces, overwhelmed by the enemy, fought a delaying action in Bataan which will be long remembered in American history. During the long, steady retreat the American and Filipino forces fought constantly against terrific odds with ever dwindling supplies and munitions. Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer's gripping drama, "Cry Havoc," tells the story of thirteen heroic women who remained on Bataan to help evacuate the wounded.

## ODEON and CURZON.

American family life in a small town is depicted in "The Sullivans," which is deservedly attracting large audiences at the Odeon and Curzon this week. Soap production in Palestine is at present carried on by 21 Jewish and 14 Arab factories outside the large Arab soap-producing centre at Nablus, where there are another 25 factories registered although not all of them are functioning. In 1943 the total output of soap in Palestine was over 10,000 tons, of which 15 per cent. was made at Nablus. Export last year was 505 tons, of which 329 tons was the hard Nablus soap, sold mostly in Trans-Jordan and Egypt. Distribution of the soap by kind during 1943 was: Ordinary soap, 6,653 tons; toilet-soap, 683 tons; soap flakes, 438 tons; soap powder, 560 tons; other kinds, 220 tons, and Nablus soap, 1,779 tons; making a total of 10,233 tons. Arab plants had a total of 2,400 tons of soap for household use, and the remainder came from Jewish factories. Last year 9,728 tons of soap were sold, of which 1,207 came from Nablus. It is interesting to note that only 957 tons of Nablus soap were sold in 1942, and last year's great increase was due to the bumper olive crop.
