Cape Town Massadah Association to have Nachlah Near Maayan Baruch.

The Massadah Association of Cape Town, which some time ago succeeded in raising £1,000 to establish a "nachlah" in Eretz Israel in its name, has at last been informed of the site of this tract of land.

Keren Kayemeth headquarters in Jerusalem have agreed to the request made by the Massadah Association that the "nachlah" should be situated in the vicinity of Maayan Baruch, the new settlement in the Galil of S.A. ex-servicemen. The "nachlah" will bear the name of the Massadah Association and will provide a further link with the "chalutzim chayalim" of Maayan Baruch, for whom Massadah has already bought a cine camera, and with whom it is maintaining a regular correspondence.

It is the intention of the Massadah Association to utilise all further money raised for the Keren Kayemeth for the redemption of yet another "nachlah" in Eretz Israel.
