## Cantor J. Saks.

Cantor J. Saks, the Johannesburg Cantor, who is well known in this country for his appearances on concert platforms and who has of late been the Cantor of Mayfair Synagogue, Johannesburg, has accepted a call from the Pretoria Hebrew Congregation to officiate during the High Festivals. Although he had a few offers for the

position of Chazan, he had to decline and accepted the Pretoria offer. Cantor Saks is the possessor of one of the finest trained tenor voices in the country, proof of which is that he won in Pretoria and Johannesburg three Gold Medals in Italian opera arias, English and Afrikaans music. He particularly excelled himself when he took the leading role of the Gypsy Singer in the Jewish operetta of that name by H. Ichilchick; he also achieved success when he appeared with John Connell's concerts in Joubert Park, also with Max Weinbren's Orchestra. Chazonuth, of course, is the main object and he has studied for the past 18 years, culminating in his being appointed Cantor to the Mayfair Synagogue, where he made a name for himself as a Chazan. Cantor Saks has studied under Professor Margotinni, Mme. Leah Williams and Burani and Ferri, and a great future is forecast for Cantor Saks in the world of Chazonuth.

The Christian Church has failed in its duty toward the Jews by not fighting strongly enough anti-Semitism and persecution and sometimes even participating in it, the World Congress of Christian Youth, which met here, declared in a sharply-worded statement protesting against Jew-hatred.

Young Christians, the statement adds, consider that Jews are equal with any other people and must have the same rights and responsibilities. It appeals to Gentile youth to seek closer relations with Jewish youth.
