Pnina Saltzman in Chopin

AT her concert on Saturday night, Pnina Saltzman presented a well arranged programme, beginning with the charming simplicity of Schumann's Scenes of Childhood, and leading to the more complex beauty of Chopin and a stirring climax of Albeniz and Liszt.

The Chopin Sonata in B, with its varying themes of passion and tranquility, was played with great depth of feeling, and with remarkable power and sincerity. Miss Saltzman always maintains perfect artistic control, and achieves her accomplished effects with fluent ease.

In the two beautiful Chopin Ballades which followed, Miss Saltzman brought the distinguished performance to a brilliant climax. Her interpretive powers were at their highest in the exquisitely sensitive expression of alternating moods of storm and calm, and the audience responded with enthusiastic applause.

The programme concluded with a dazzling rendering of three short Albeniz pieces and Liszt's Hungarian Rhapsody No. 12.

Miss Saltzman will give her final orchestral concert at the City Hall on Tuesday night, July 4, at 7.45 p.m., when she will appear with the Johannesburg Symphony Orchestra. She will play Chopin E Minor Concerto, and the Symphonic Variations, Cesar Franck.

Johannesburg Music Society

MISS BETSY DE LA PORTE and Lorenzo Danza were the performers at the Johannesburg Musical Society concert in the Selborne Hall last Wednesday. Miss de la Porte sang the dramatic aria from Andromache's Lament (Max Bruce) in her powerful and controlled voice. The programme included an interesting selection of songs by two South African composers, W. H. Bell and Professor P. R. Kirby.

Lorenzo Danza played Beethoven's Sonata in A flat with sensitivity and precision, and his rendering of Chopin's Nocturne in D flat and Ballade IV in F Minor was particularly fine.

All Russian Concert

AN attractive all-Russian programme was presented by the S.A. Friends of the Soviet Union at the Metro Theatre on Sunday evening, conducted by Theo Wendt. Tchaikovsky lovers were delighted by Bram Verhoef's performance of the Violin Concerto and the Letter Scene from "Eugen Onegin," sung by Betsy de la Porte.

Mr. Verhoef played with his usual fine intonation and polish, and he gave an accomplished and sensitive interpretation of this difficult work. Miss de la Porte has a beautifully modulated contralto voice, and she sang the dramatic aria with great strength and delicacy.

The programme included ballet music by Glazounov, and the ever popular Tchaikovsky "1812" Overture. The concert concluded with the playing of the new Soviet Anthem.
