Family Gardens in Benoni

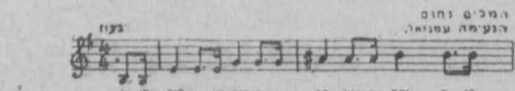

- (4) Mr. and Mrs. L. Miller on the occasion of their silver wedding inscribed by their children.

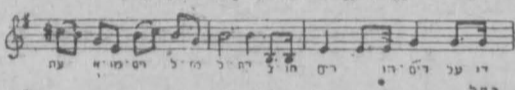
Marching Song of the Brigade

Below we publish the marching song of the Jewish Brigade, reproduced from "Lahayal," the daily newspaper for Jewish soldiers in Europe

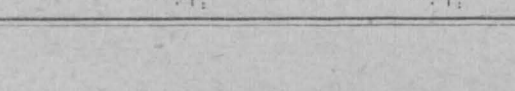
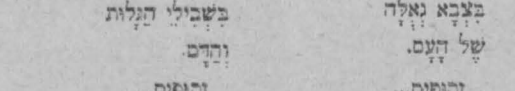
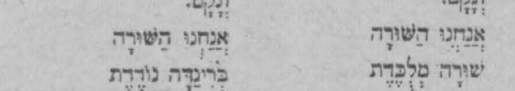
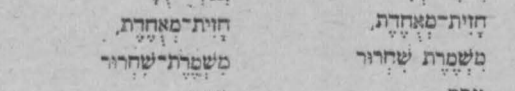
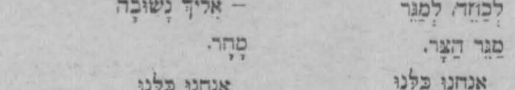
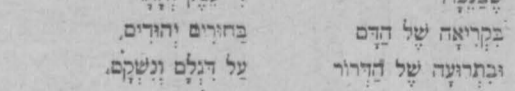
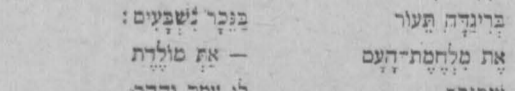
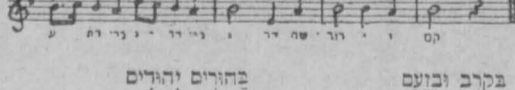
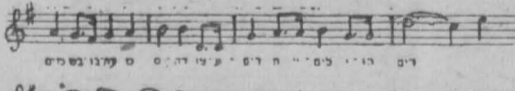
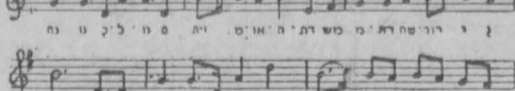
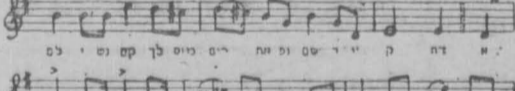
