Rev. O. Altshuler Addresses Mizrachi Bible Class

Rev. O. Altshuler was the speaker at the Mizrachi Bible Class on June 8, when he dealt with Chapter 10 of the Prophet Jeremiah.

He devoted part of his address to a discussion of Jewish education, declaring that the ideal aim should be to train our youth in such a way that they would be able to serve both God and man.

PIANO AND VIOLIN RECITAL

A pianoforte and violin recital was given by Bruno Raikin and Eugen Magid for the Johannesburg Musical Society at the Carlton Hotel on Sunday, June 17. Their programme was interesting and varied, and the artists showed skill and efficiency, particularly in their solo items.

Mr. Raikin was at his best in the Fugues by Liszt and the Sonata No. 2 by Prokofieff which he played with precision and understanding. His playing of Schuman's Fantasia Stucke lacked the romantic charm which is associated with this particular work. Mr. Magid gave a robust and spirited interpretation of the Rhapsody by Liszt, Dohnanyi and the Zapatendo by Sarasate.

MR. TAGER ADDRESSES P.E. HISTADRUTH IVRITH

A report dealing with the visit of Mr. N. Kirschner, chairman of the S.A. Zionist Federation, and Mr. L. Tager, member of the Federation's Executive Council, to the Eastern Provinces, appeared last week. In it reference was made to an address delivered by Mr. Tager to the Port Elizabeth Histadruth Ivrit. A more detailed report of this meeting has now reached us.

"The Position of Jewry in Europe and the Economic Possibilities of Eretz Israel" was the subject of Mr. Tager's address which he delivered in Hebrew. The meeting was held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lichter, and not the home of Mr. and Mrs. Sendin, as was erroneously stated. There was a large attendance.

Mr. J. Mizrachy, the chairman, introduced the speaker and spoke of Mr. Tager's devotion to Zionism, his love for the Hebrew language and the interest taken by him in promoting the speaking of Hebrew in this country.
