## Hebrew Correspondence Course Established in America

As a result of the recent growth of public interest in the study of the Hebrew language, the Histadruth Ivrit of America, devoted to the spreading of Hebrew culture, is inaugurating a correspondence course in elementary Hebrew to begin early in June.

Similar courses have been introduced in England and other countries with extremely satisfactory results. The course will be based on Prof. Zvi Scharfstein's recent book, "Hebrew Self-Taught." The course itself will be conducted by Simcha Rubinstein, one of the outstanding Hebrew educators in the United States. The committee, consisting of leading Jewish educators in this country, includes: Judah Pilch, Jacob S. Golub, Rabbi Theodore Friedman and Rabbi Goodman.

While the course is scheduled to provide weekly lessons to students, it will be so designed that it will not handicap those who have the ability to learn faster, since several lessons will be mailed at one time to those desiring it. The first elementary course will be followed by an advanced course later in the year.

The course is given under the supervision of the Correspondence Course Department of the Histadruth Ivrit of America, at 165 West 46th Street, New York City.
