IMPORTANT NOTICE BY THE LOCAL BETH-DIN

It has come to the notice of the Beth-Din that among the ingredients commonly used by bakers and confectioners is a fat which contains a large admixture of whale oil. Whale oil is treife, with the result that bread and confectionery made with these ingredients are not suitable for Jewish consumption. The Beth-Din is pursuing its enquiries in this matter and hopes to be able to make some statement shortly as to the exact position and as to the availability of bread and confectionery which is Kosher.

At the moment the only bread in whose baking this treife fat is not used is the oval rye loaf, which is not baked in tins.

At the same time the Beth-Din wishes to make it known that the different kinds of oil for domestic use, such as Epic oil, Cotona oil, Universal oil, Covo oil and Purene vegetable fat in packets, are of pure vegetable origin and can be used without question in all Jewish houses as strictly Kosher.
