Few people realise that 3rd Ear (Est. 1969 . . . . and going for a few years before then) was built for a song. A *local* song at that.

Now after 10 and more years of building, using the weirdest methods possible — with help from all kinds of people — 3rd Ear music is slowly becoming noticed . . . . because, we believe, people are starting to *listen* . . . . to their own, here at home.

All we need now is a little bit more Fair Air Support — while we keep building up here down at ground level . . . . digging deeper underground, where conventional record companies fear to tread — tum-dee-dummmmm

After all, we believe that's where the *gold* is — and by trying to avoid all the necessary hype, we want you to help us introduce all types of local words and music, firstly to the people here at home, and then to others who would like to hear.

A few recent *commercial* successes seem to have placed our *creative credibility* in a few awkward (?) positions... we don't mind what/how people *think* as long as they *listen!* We plan to use these commercial gains to expand our aims and preserving, presenting and protecting indigenous sounds of all and any kind.

3rd Ear music takes no sides . . . . and we record everything and anything that we believe is *important* . . . in one or other way . . . . We have collected over one and a quarter million feet of tape . . . . every inch of that magnetic tape is indigenous, and a good 90 percent. of it recorded on location, *live!* We might not come up to technical (record) scratch, but we certainly try to catch the moment . . . and that's what music is all about.

It starts with people, and gets back to them via many various, varied and complicated means. Somewhere along the line though, the whole idea of music via records and recordings has got lost in amongst such big words as product, sales, figures, PVC, profits, prophets, radio, transistors, ego, competition, etc.... We want to keep in touch — so we won't get bigger than we can reach.

We do not look or listen to music with the aim of competing with anybody . . . . we know that we have got to make do with what we've got . . . . Having just come into the age of Television, there is no way we can *compete* with a culture that's been walking on the moon for ten years . . . . the least we can do though, is to give them a tune or two to whistle while they're up there . . . .
