

MIKE DE JAGER

Mike plays a custom built Callaghan. This wonderful guitar, made by Durban guitar maker Kerry Callaghan, is his favourite. He started off on an acoustic 1969 Gallotone.

He has been known in and around Durban for more than 20 years as an "ace rock guitarist". Although a stylist in his own right, his major influences are Jimi Hendrix, Steve Vai, Joe Sat-



riani and Garry Moore. Mike performs regularly in "action bar" bands, and runs his own Midi Suite 8 track studio. Ever the man to help South African musicians in general, Mike also manages a music magazine, specifically for musicians (and in particular guitarists) called South African Musician and Record-



Sandile Shange is one of South Africa's foremost jazz guitarists, playing the standard repertoire as well as township jazz. He has also composed a number of pieces that are becoming known all around the country.

A totally self-taught musician, Sandile's aim is to make his music commercially successful as well as accepted in interna-

tional circles. His playing reflects three traditions: Zulu guitar playing – making use of open strings; unusual tunings and finger pickings – township styles, emphazizing strumming rhythmic patterns; and the mainsteam tradition. The remarkable thing about his playing is that he combines all three styles so naturally into something completely new and his own.




SYD KITCHEN

DAVID GRESHAM RECORDS ARE PROUD TO RELEASE "THE STORYTELLER", THE SECOND SOLO ALBUM BY CLASSICAL GUITARIST, DAVID HEWITT.

DAVID BEGAN HIS MUSICAL CAREER AS A ROCK 'N ROLL SINGER AND ELECTRIC GUITAR PLAYER. HIS MUSICAL AMBITIONS CHANGED DRAMATICALLY HOWEVER, WHEN HE MET CLASSICAL MAESTRO FRITZ BUSS. HE WENT ON TO STUDY WITH THE CELEBRATED CONCERT GUITARIST NARCISO YEPES AND RECORDED DUETS WITH MUSICOLOGIST AND GUITARIST SIMON WYNBERG IN LONDON.


LIVING IN AFRICA AND SURROUNDED FROM A YOUNG AGE WITH THE CROSSWINDS OF AFRICAN AND WESTERN CULTURES, IT WAS NATURAL THAT DAVID'S WORK SHOULD REFLECT BOTH HIS CLASSICAL TRAINING AND THE INFLUENCES OF THE LAND IN WHICH HE LIVES.

HIS DEBUT ALBUM "AN AFRICAN TAPESTRY" WAS VERY SUCCESSFUL IN SOUTH AFRICA AND IT WAS RELEASED IN SEVERAL COUNTRIES, INCLUDING GERMANY, KOREA AND USA. "AN AFRICAN TAPESTRY" ALSO EARNED DAVID THE MUCH COVETED OKTV AWARD FOR "BEST INSTRUMENTAL ALBUM" IN APRIL 1990.

"THE STORYTELLER", DAVID'S NEW ALBUM, CONTINUES WHERE "AN AFRICAN TAPESTRY" LEFT OFF. IT CAPTURES THE ESSENCE OF AFRICAN CULTURE THROUGH THE COMBINED EFFECTS OF CLASSICAL GUITAR WITH ORCHESTRAL UNDERTONES, TRADITIONAL ETHNIC INSTRUMENTS AND RHYTHMS.

ON "THE STORYTELLER", DAVID COMBINES HIS TALENT WITH THAT OF NARRATOR\STORYTELLER GCINA MHLOPE, WHO SPINS HER FOLKLORE TALES OVER DAVID'S GUITAR MAGIC TO CREATE A MUSICAL STORYBOOK.

AS WITH THE FIRST ALBUM, "THE STORYTELLER" BRINGS TOGETHER THE TEAM OF INTERNATIONAL ARRANGER ADOLFO WAITZMAN, ENGINEER\PRODUCER PETER THWAITES AND THE HOLY JERUSALEM CHURCH CHOIR. ALSO FEATURED ON THE ALBUM ARE AMAMPONDO ON PERCUSSION AND NTOKOZO ZUNGA (EX-STIMELA) ON MBAGANGA GUITAR.



THE FIRST SINGLE FROM THE ALBUM IS THE LIVELY "INGUDUDU — THE RAINBIRD", WHICH FEATURES GCINA MHLOPE NARRATING. OTHER STUNNING TRACKS TO LISTEN OUT FOR ARE "WHERE THE HEART IS", "NOMKHITHA — SHE WHO TURNS MENS HEADS" AND "SHARE THE FIRE"

EACH TRACK IS A STORY RELATING TO AFRICAN FOLKLORE, AND THESE STORIES ARE FEATURED ON THE ALBUM'S GATEFOLD SLEEVE.

APART FROM A LITTLE 'TWEEK' ON THE FINAL TRACK OF THE ALBUM, NO SEQUENCES OR SYNTHESISERS WERE USED DURING THE RECORDING PROCESS. EVEN THE SOUND MADE BY THE "GROUND HORNBILL" WAS RECORDED AUTHENTICALLY AND COMES LIVE FROM THE BUSH.

SO SIT BACK, RELAX AND LET DAVID HEWITT TRANSPORT YOU TO ANOTHER TIME ... WHERE THE DUST OF AFRICA BLOWS GENTLE TALES ACROSS THE CONTINENT.
