

THIRD EAR AUDIO SOUND.

David Marks spent almost a year in the USA working for one of the largest, and most respected Audio Sound companies in the USA, the Boston/New York based HANLEY SOUND INC.

In 1971 Hanley sent out about R10,000.00 worth of Altec, Crown, Shure and JBL sound equipment to the RSA, after Marks had told him of the 'appaulling' audio sound conditions in this country. It was only after a few years and quiet a number of "free" outings, that agents, promote and managers started realsing that they would HAVE to pay more attentiand money, towards 'Audio Sound' in the presentation of their shows.

Infact, it was the 'Black' promoters, who were presenting shows to crowds of up to 10,000 people, who were the first to use, what was, & still is the largest Public Address system in Africa.

As soon as the 'Hanley' system started working non stop thru '72 & '73 minus people (audiances) became aware of what the performers were tryto get thru all these years, unsuccessfully, with a 200 watt power amplifier, column speakers and a microphone. It also proved to promoter that although the audiances are not AWARE of it, one of the prime factors of crowd unrest and violence, at a good time (music) gathering was the fact that what they were (not) hearing was sub-consciously irratating. Even at smaller gatherings and Club meetings, where Music is supposed to be an uninhibited escape, relaxation, pleasure, etc, one can almost "feel" the violent 'vibrations.' In many cases it is the 'boring' performances manifested by a bad sound, because even a 'boring' performer can get 'out of it' and become a little happiness if he's at least getting accross:

There is as Noticable a difference between "Body" and "Volume" as there is between "Clarity" and "Distortion." Volume and distortion can never create an atmosphere, especially when ones ears have grown accustomed to fine Hi-Fidelity recordings. A sound can be LOUD and pleasant without thaving to be an edurance test on the brain, as modern recording techniques have proved, and there is NO difference NEWE between a THIRI EAR public address system, as we have devolped it to-day, and the mixing console of a recording studio, amplified 10 times.

Today, all based on the Hanley System, there are a number of good sophisticated Audio Sound Hire companies. But then there are still a great number of Agencies, Promoters and managers who, rether than pay the price of a good sound system, insist on taking the general public for as much as possible.

Third Ear though, is still the only company with speakers large and capable enough, of getting a full dynamic audio sound, outdoors, and our Altec designed 4-10 Bass Cabinets (7'x3'x3's' weight 300lbs each) are still the only speakers available in Africa to "Throw" the Low frequencies, the frequencer that gets lost more than any other at an open air meeting.

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
