Durban Tracks for this debut album by Music Producer & Song Writer DAVID MARKS, are being recorded from Durban via "digital LAN Lines" to the SABC's RADIO PARK MUSIC STUDIOS in Johannesburg on Wednesday 2nd April.

About 50 Musicians with whom David has worked & produced in his 30 years as a Sound Engineer, record producer & songwriter, have contributed to this 14 track 'lyrical' & 'acoustic based' CD, which will be completed for release in mid 1997.

The Digital Technology that connects Studios around the world has been used only twice before in South Africa - by MANGO GROOVE who connected from TOKYO to the SABC in Johannesburg & on David's HIDDEN YEARS Album in January, when 8 Cape Town musicians recorded from the SABC studios in Sea Point to the M5 Studios in Auckland Park, Johannesburg.

The recordings on Wednesday 2nd April in Durban will feature percussionist & producer DAN CHIORBOLI, & DAVID'S family of musicians: Brother-in-Law singer

songwriter, LEN DOWNING, mother-in-law Piano & Choir teacher, LEONIE DOWNING, wife FRAN & daughters LISHA & ROSE-LEE MARKS, with ad-hoc appearances by his two sons, both guitarists, DYLAN & ARLO.

There will be guest appearances by David's musician friends STEVE FATAAR, KEN E HENSON, SYD KITCHEN & MADALA KUNENE.

To complete the project musicians HUGH MASEKELA, MANFRED MANN (in London), SHAWN PHILLIPS (in Los Angeles) & on their return from the USA LADYSMITH BLACK MAMBAZO, will also make guest appearances.

The CD is being Produced for 3rd Ear Music Productions & Radio Park Music by DAVID MARKS & ALAN JUDD & Engineered by EVERT DE MUNNIK.

All the songs were composed by DAVID between 1964 & 1994 - the irony being that some of the songs, recorded by other artists in the 60's & 70's, & which were often 'avoided' or 'banned', are now being sponsored by the SABC. New &

old songs are included in the collection with three early hits, MOUNTAINS of MEN (1966), MASTER JACK (1968) & CLEAR, COOL, CALM & STILL (1969). The 'BASIC BAND' comprised of Durban's maestro Guitarist & Arranger ALAN JUDD, Drummer VUSI KHUMLAO, Bassist CONCORDE NKABINDE & Durban's Keyboard wizard, JOE DELEW. DAVID on acoustic guitar did the vocals.
