THE SHOW: Brian Finch and Kenny Henson are returning to the Market Cafe to recreate the excitement they caused at the same venue in November last year. Their show opens for a three week run on Tuesday the 22nd of March at 8.30p.m.

Brain and Kenny, both highly respected musicians, have an eight year old musical relationship. "Whenever the opportunity arises, I sit in and jam with Brian," says Henson. "We are both free agents at the moment so we've decided to go for it as a duo. We have both contributed material and are busy working on close harmony vocals - it is really happening for us." With Finch's fiery rythym guitar and strong vocal style, Henson's driving lead guitar and their combined song writing talents they have plenty to offer.

BRIAN FINCH: Brian Finch started singing professionally in the mid sixties.

He built up a large following and an enviable reputation as a folk singer with a unique style and a great voice. "My only problem was that I felt limited performing material that other people had written. There were ideas that I wanted to express and in 1970 I found that I was able to translate these ideas into songs." Finch hasn't looked back since. In 1973 he toured Europe and worked as a singer in London and Amsterdam. Since his return he has released an album and a number of singles and has worked steadily in Durban, Jefferies Bay and Johannesburg. Finch is just a step away from the international recognition that he richly deserves. His records have already been released in Australia and New Zealand.

KENNY HENSON: Kenny Henson has proved his worth as a musician time and again.

He was a founder member of Abstract Truth and Freedoms Children.

He has been musical director for "Godspell", "Fangs" and the Realistics. He has written music for films and plays. He is recognised by his peers as South Africa' greatest rock guitarist. He has written and performed songs, suites, symphonies. The word "genius" often comes up in conversation about Henson. If only one of our cloth-eared record company executives would LISTEN
