The idea of "PILGRIM" sprang from the work that Toby Robertson, the Director of England's famous Prospect Theatre Company, had been doing with composer Carl Davis over a number of years. They first worked together in television for the B.B.C. Wednesday Play series, and then in the theatre on "EDWARD II", "VENICE PRESERVED", "KING LEAR", and on the "BEGGAR'S OPERA" for the Phoenix Opera Company. Both composer and director were anxious to extend the use of music in the Prospect Company's work and their first major production along these lines was the 'pop' version of "LOVE'S LABOURS LOST". Here, apart from the songs specified by Shakespeare, the lovers' sonnets were all set to music, and sections of prose as well. This worked so happily for them that they went on to develop this in "PERICLES" which was set in the Mytilene brothel, with a band permanently on stage. The masque-like quality of "PERICLES" was enhanced by an almost continuous use of music.

Having worked on two classics in a modern setting, they decided to embark on a third. The Periclean notion of Man's life as a journey echoed in the highway rhythms of Bob Dylan's generation led to "PILGRIM'S PROGRESS". By a rock musical approach, they wanted to emphasise the modernity of the morality story and the naivety of Bunyans' original; a quality which Jane McCulloch has admirably caught in her lyrics for the show, many of which are a faithful re-working of Bunyan's text.

Rhodesian audiences may be interested to know that Carl Davis is also the composer of the title music for the popular T.V. series "The World at War".




