We are planning to hold a regular series of concert tours featuring some of South Africa's most popular recording and performing artists - initially we plan to concentrate on rural areas and eventually hold a series of bigger urban/city festivals. Durban based musicians constitute by far the largest proportion of commercial music sales in South Africa and we aim to establish Natal's music autonomy.

Our intention is to try and collaborate with an interested sponsor. The groups we would like to use on this first tour would be chosen from the following:

These artists are amongst the most popular in South Africa today with the Soul Brothers and Black Moses being among the biggest selling recording artists in the country.

The plan to establish these smaller but more frequent concert tours stems from our twenty years experience in setting up and working on this country's biggest festivals and tours, eg on behalf of 3rd Ear Music I have personally worked on the Lion Lager Road Show, the Carling Circle of Jazz, to name a few.


Could we, together with Afro Music Promotions, meet with you at your earliest convenience and discuss this project.
