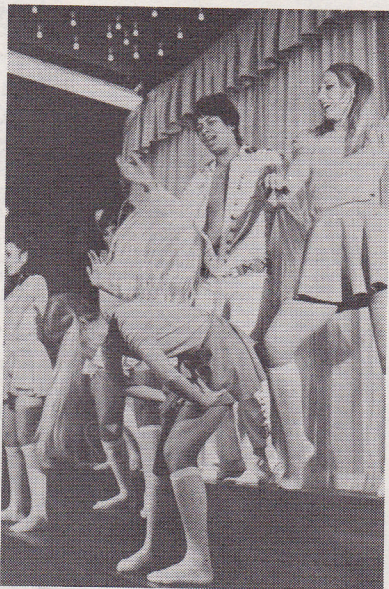

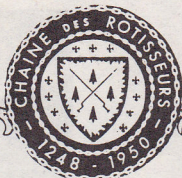
AROUND&ABOUT Southern Swingers
