## in Tiervlei

**BOUT 200 rate-payers attended** A the official opening of the new R45,500 Community Centre for Coloured people in Florida Estate, Tiervlei (Parow) recently.

The Mayor of Parow, Mr. F. N. Kriel, who performed the official opening of this imposing building, said that two important projects for the Coloured community in the area had been tackled. The centre, he said, was one, and the housing scheme was the other. Originally the Council intended that the housing scheme should provide only for Coloured people who were living in White areas, but it had been decided that it should now be extended to help those people who live in poor homes as well.

Mr. Kriel told his attentative audience, that there were now 329 homes in the area, but that this figure would be extended to 800 in due course. Work on the clinic, he added, would soon start.

Adjoining the new centre modern in interior and exterior design . stands a well-equipped library built recently.
