How to cast your 2 ballots in the voting hall

There are essentially ten stages to the voting process:



Checking hands: The voter places his/her hands under an ultra-wolet lamp to make a further test if he/she has already voted Voters who have already voted will exhibit stains on the hands which are visible only under ultra-wolet, light. If there are no stains, the voter will be allowed to proceed to the next stage.



Show your ID: After entering the voting station, the voter presents fruster is for other active enginging document to the voting Office. If the identification is valid and the voter hat not voter allowed, the will be allowed to proceed to the second stage.



Marking of hands: The voter dips his/her knuckles into a dish containing a special liquid. The voter's knuckles will be illained, but the stain will not be visible to the naked eyil. This non-toxic stain will fade in about seven days.



will hand his/her ID document or temporary voter card to an official who will mark it, and a National Assembly ballot paper will then be given to the voter with his/her ID document.
