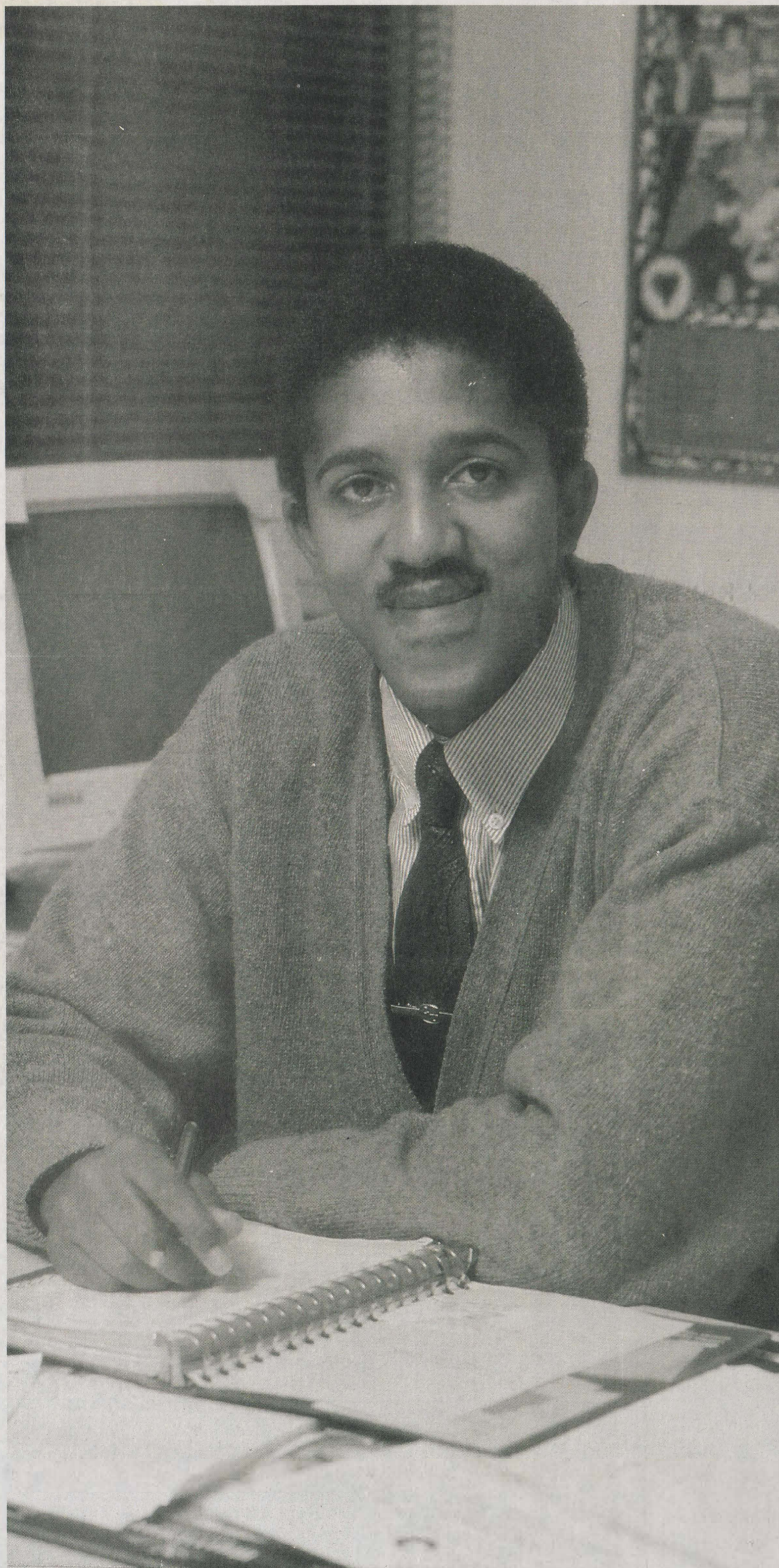


“I am a marketing man and I’m voting National Party.”
