PROPOSAL ON WAY FORWARD : LOCAL GOVERNMENT

- 1. Proposals implemented should be consistent with requirements of the Local Government Transitional Act (LGTA), 1993.
- 2. Keep in mind the agreement consistent with the provision of the Act, at the SDF, to accept a total of 22 sitting Councillors for the area "Town", Cloetesville, Idas Valley and Kaya Mandi.
- 3. It means 11 Councillors (Statutory) and 11 Councillors (Non-statutory).
- That is consistent with the 50/50 principle as embodied by the Transitional Local Council model. (This is nonnegotiable).
- 5. The satellite towns will get 2 Councillors each, bearing in mind that Pniel and Johannesdal viewed as one area, i.e. Jamestown (2), Kylemore (2), Pniel/Johannesdal (2) = 6 (22 + 6 = 28).
- If the Demarcation Board rules in favour of Klapmuts' inclusion to the Stellenbosch Forum area, they get 2 Councillors (22 + 8 = 30).
- Councillors' allowances will have to be reduced in order to attain cost-effectiveness.

We break it up as follows: Area "Stat" "Non-stat" Total Cloetesville, Idasvallev, Kava Mandi and Town 11 11 22 Satellite towns: B. Jamestown 2 Kylemore 2 Pniel/Johannesdal 2 Klapmuts 2

- The full members can submit a tentative list of candidates (in order of priority) to the Secretary of the Techni-8. cal Committee.
- This list, however, should be endorsed by the Executive and General meetings of members.

- 10. A detailed break-up of number of stat or non-stat representatives are presumptions because finality has not yet been reached by the Provincial Committee on the five aspirant "non-stat" members.
- 11. The Facilitators should be satisfied that all nominations followed the required procedure.
- 12. The Technical Committee (who members now view as representative) should try to compile a short list of v candidates.
- 13. It should be referred to the CWC for further debate and motivation and then to the SNF for discussion and acceptance.
- 14. It then should be sent to the Provincial Committee for publication.

These proposals are supported by Stellenbosch Civic and Jamestown Civic.
