## DE POLITIEKE TOESTAND.

HET is even onderhoudend als leeryk om op te lettend de verschillende indrukken nategnen, die op verschillende personen door de beschouwing van hetzelfde voorwerp gemaakt worden. Steeds moet men iets toegeven aan het verschillend standpunt der beschouwers, waardoor het voorwerp zich steeds eensig anders voordoet. Ook kan het oogen waarmede de waarneming gedaan wordt van verschillend gehalte zyn. Hieruit ontstaat ongelijkheid der verwoerdelyke en heftige twist, die eenraal over de kleur van het verkleurde manje woeide. Ook wordt van een byzonder vernuftig in Y-reeks timmerman verbaasd, dat hy gedurende zeker jaar waarin het voer reer schaarsch was, en er in zyn vak niet veel te doen was, enige moeite had om in de behoefte van syn paard te voorzien. Zulke tegenspoeden komen er in andere landen dan Amerika voor, maar de vindingracht der Yankees kan zich met elke moeite vergelijken, die in den weg komt, meten. En dus was het met den timmerman. Hy kon geen haver ooi koopen, en dus beledige hy het weinige dat hy over had in een paar ontaagdekoek gelegen hingelingen voor syn paard. Het duurde toegestaan dat werd op des timmerman binnenaanplaats gebragt, en begon gulig de houtkuilen te vreten, die hy voor grondzag. Of het paard door dit nieuwe soort voer er beter op werd, wordt niet gemeld.

Eenige onzer voorname politieke schryveren schynen, als hy de last te verkrijgen beproken, ongeveer in den tweestand van het Amerikaansche paard te verkeeren. Zij hadden een groene bril opgezet, en wille alles rondom zich groen zien. Als dit gebeurt zal Lord Derby een plaet in het Kabinet kryzen zonder portefeuille; Lord Stanley zal het Huis der Gemeenten leiden als herste Lord der Schatkist, en de heer Disraeli raad de Lords gezonden worden. Van Sir St. F. Northcote wordt als Kansellier der Schatkist gesproken. De enige waar- schynlyke kans voor het mi-ster is een beroep op het land dat willegt sal gedaan worden.

Er is een vergeefse poging aangewend op den Keizer van Rusland te vermoeden.

Het Amerikaansche Huys der Vertegenwoordigers heeft de Civil Rights Bill tegen het veto van den President aangenomen. Men meent, dat de President dat weigeren om den Bill in werking te brengen, en dat dae in dat geval hem in staat van beschuldiging sal stellen.

De Fenians hebben zich in grooten getale op de gronden van Nieuw-Brunswick verzaakt. Hunne beroepen werden door Britse kanonneerbooten galoeslagen.

Op de Niagara gronden verwachten men een inval. D. Reade heeft bervelen uitgeraagd voor het bewaren der sydzijdelykheid.

Oostenryk heeft een Pruisen voorgesteld om beiden te ontwapenen, maar heerscht nog veel onrust en vrees voor een oorlog.

In Italië worden toevertrouwen gemaakt om een Venetiaanse te trekken; het Oostenrykische leger aldaar is op voort van oorlog gesteld.

De hofding der Abyssinische gevangenen is officieel bekend gemacht.

De CHOLERA is te Rotterdam mitgebroken.

Een vreselyke tornado is over een gedeelte der Verenigde Staten gegaan, en vele menschen hebben het leven verloren.

Langs de kust van Noorwegen heeft men een berig schokener aardbeving gevoeld.

De Norewae is des 15den April in Engeland aangekomen.

MAURITIUS.—Met de *Duisland*, die 13 Mei van Mauritius vertrok, en te Port Elizabeth is aangekomen, syn de volgende marktberichten ontvangen. Er gaat niet in suiker om. In de pakhuizen te Port Louis liggen ontront 47.000 zakken, waaren 34.000 den één suiker in 6.000 den meer gehouden worden. De laatste oogst is ongeveer 120.000 tonnen geweest, die ontront 22.000.000 hebben opgeleverd. De balans zal even alle verloren jaare ten gunste der kolonie zijn, daer de invoer niet zo groot is geweest als gewoonlyk. Ryst en andere artikelen van voedsel zijn door de laatste aanvoer gelukkig gedaald.

Miel is overschot en doet 8 tot 9 dollars voor Amerikaansch; & 45 tot 47 dollars voor Chië. De 19<sup>th</sup> Fransche, die per "Zebra" is ingevoerd, heeft 10.50 tot 11 dollars gehaald, maar grote hoeveelheden werden verwacht.

Visch.—Snoek doet 9 dollars; geelbek 5.50, en silverside 4.10 per 100 lbs. Deze hoge prijzen zyn daer de schaarsheid toe te schryven. Men verwacht 2.500 bundels van de Kasp, maar daar de markt gekleig is, sal dit weinig invloed op de prijzen uitoefenen.
