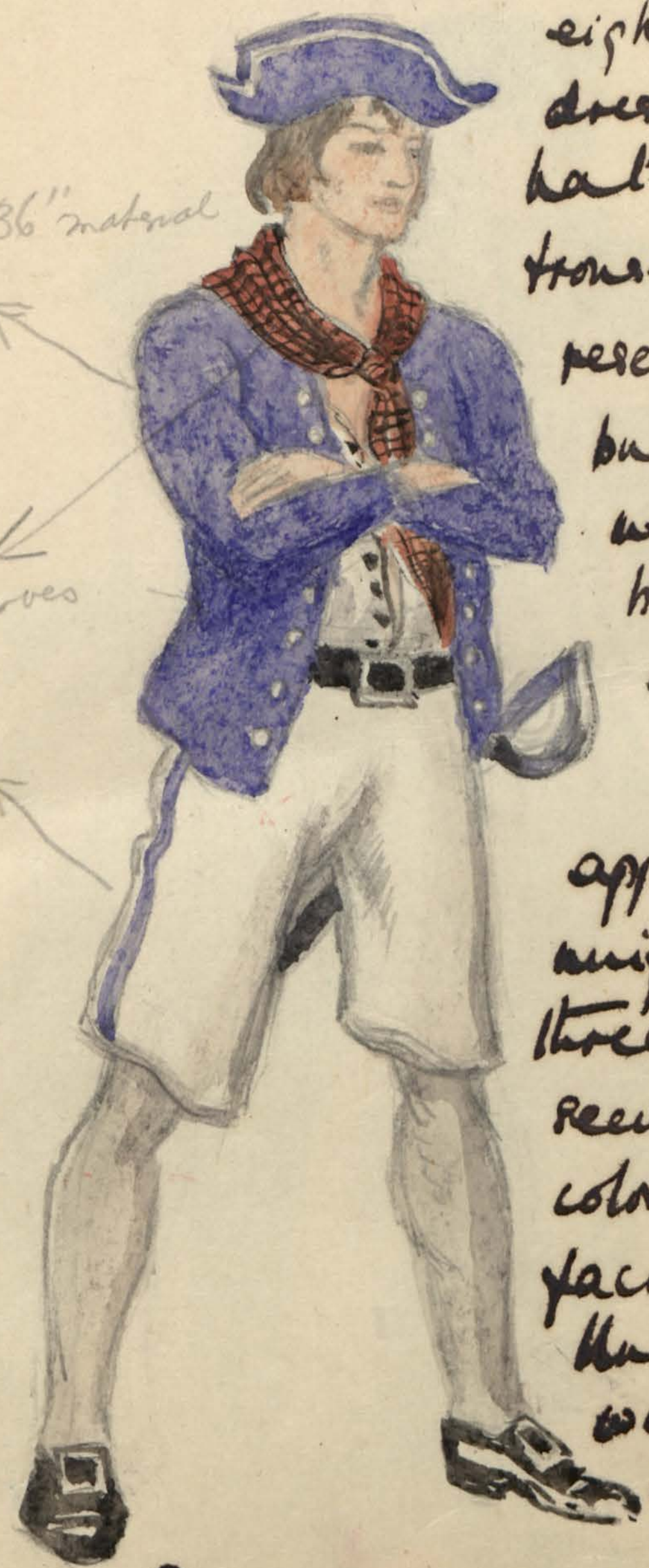
In the middle of the eighteenth century the seaman's dress was a small, low cocked hat, a pea-jacket, petticoat-trousers (the short-wide breeches resembling a kilt), ~~the hair~~ buckled shoes. The hair was allowed to grow long, but was not queued till a later date.

The officers had something approaching a distinctive uniform also. Gold-braided three-cornered hats; blue seems to have been the accepted colour for coats. These had white facings & cuffs with brass buttons. Underneath was a long white waistcoat, knee-breeches of white, with white stockings & buckled shoes were worn.

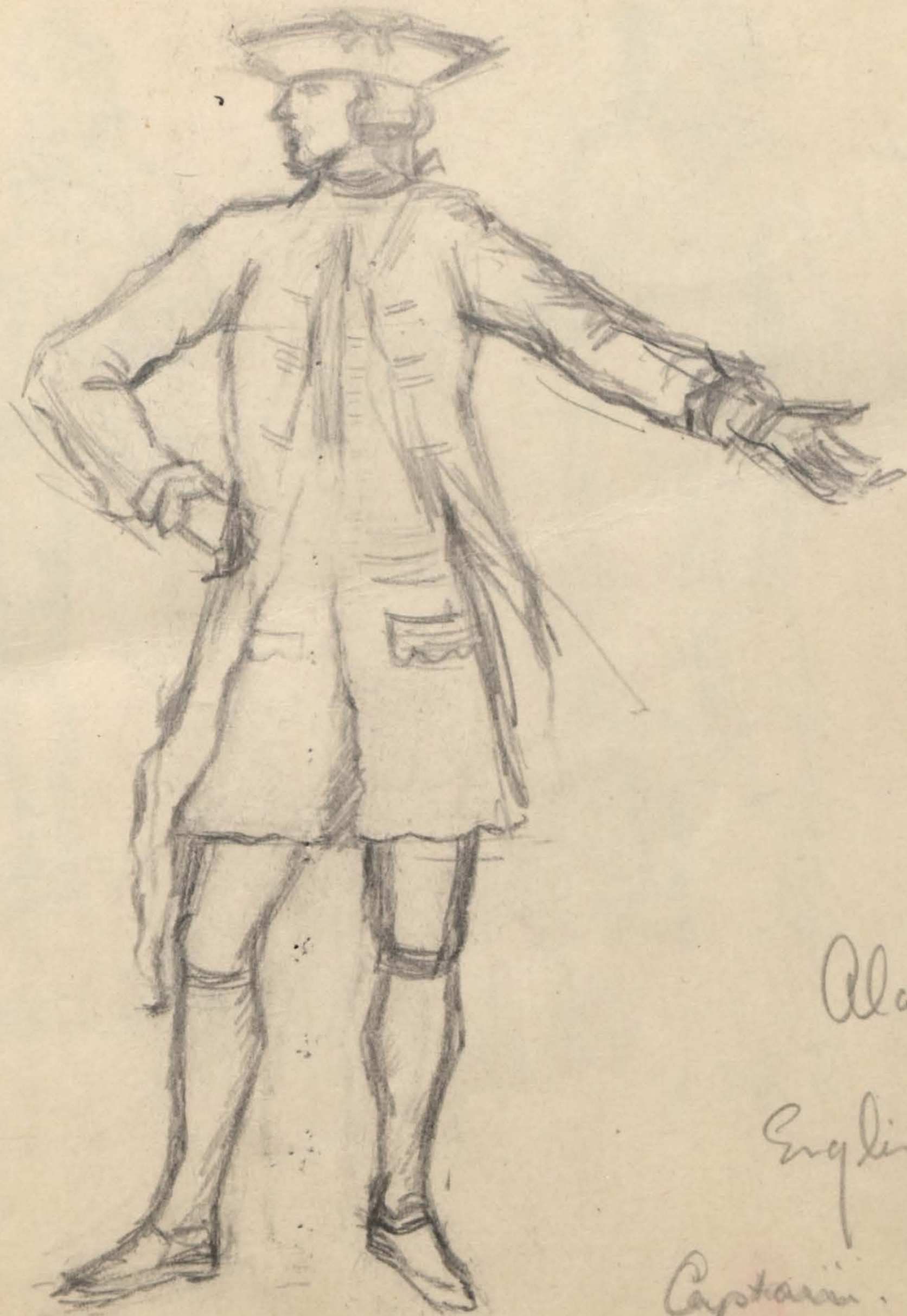

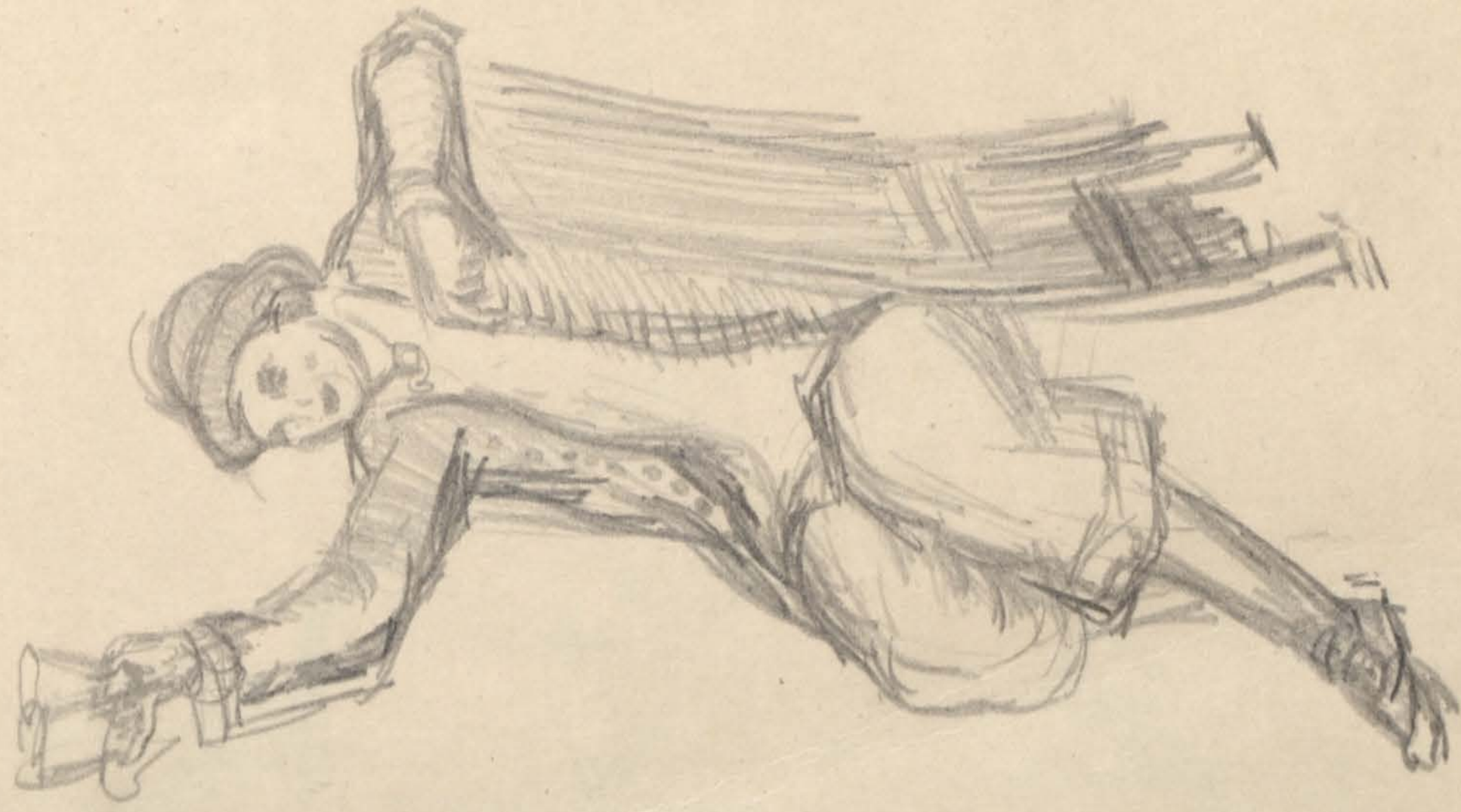

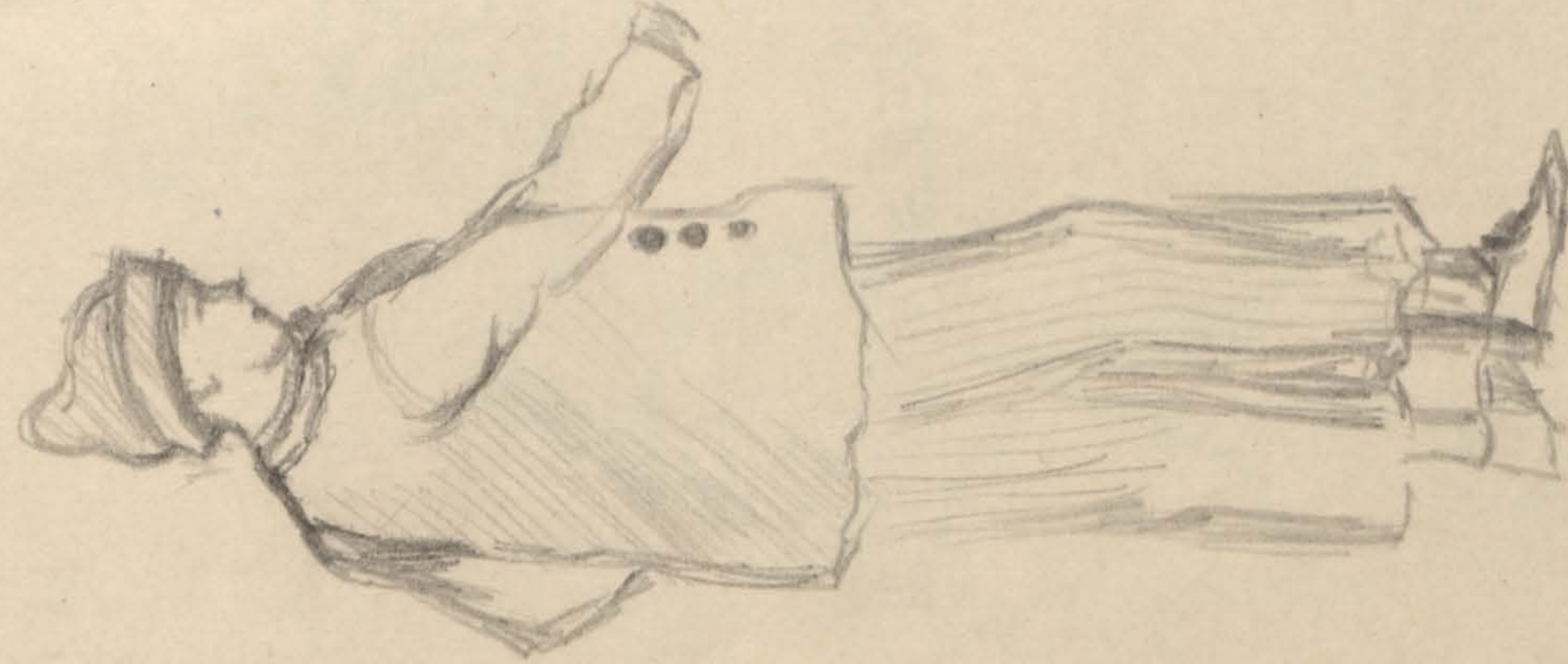
