

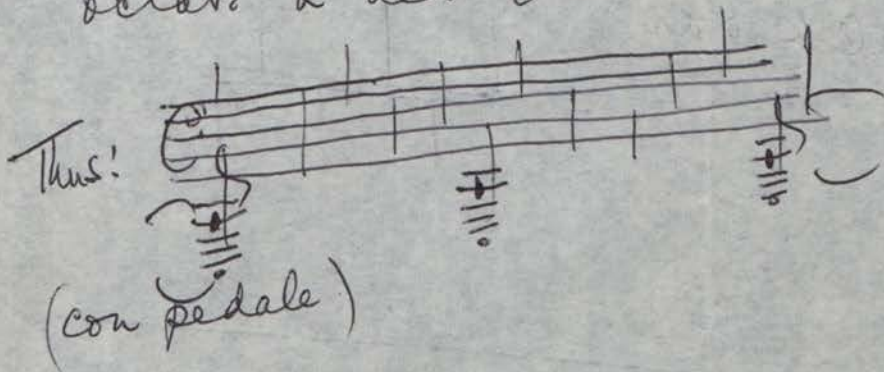

Note value in left hand written as dotted crotchets  
<sup>surely</sup> is <sup>in</sup> correct? Should not the quaver beat at the  
end of each bar be tied to a quaver & the note  
<sup>sustained</sup> ~~held~~ "con pedale"? The next octave in left hand  
should be a crotchet (not dotted) & the last  
octave a tied quaver.



Pages 12, 13.

Note-values again in bass - Instead of dotted  
minim & odd quaver at end of each bar  
this: = - ♩ ♪ ♪ ♪ ♪ would be correct? It  
is in three parts, west or pas? (Reply: English please!)

Should the orchestral part be in Octaves throughout?
