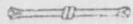


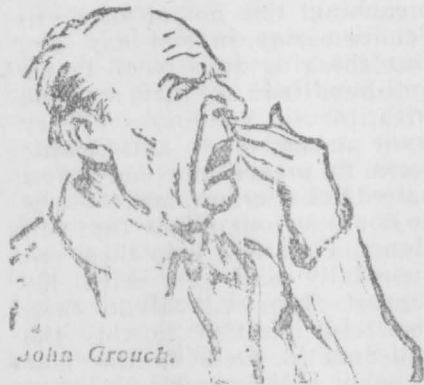
**A Chanuka Concert.**

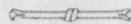
