

THE MACCABEAN FETE.

The Maccabean Fete, which is to be held on behalf of the South African Jewish Orphanage, and the South African Jewish War Memorial Hall, in the Town Hall from November 30th to December 2nd, 1926, promises to be a most successful effort.

Morris, K.C., presided over a large attendance at the first meeting held at the Carlton Hotel on July 29th, at which meeting it was decided that the sum of £150 be fixed as a quota for each Stall, for which convenors would be responsible prior to the opening of the Fete.
