Shabos Sh'oovah.

In this week's Sedra, Deut., chap.
32, verses 46, 47, we read ". . .
Set your hearts unto all the words
which I testify among you this day,
which ye shall command your chil-
dren to observe to do, all the words
of this law . . . because it is
your life; and through this thing
ye shall prolong your days in the
land, whither ye go . . ."

These two verses are the closing
words of the parting message which
Moses gave the Children of Israel
before he was ordered to go up
Mount Nebo, where he was to find
his last resting place. He not only
commands them to observe the Torah
but also "Asher tetzavum es
beneichem," "which ye shall com-
mand your children." Moses knew
well that unless the younger genera-
tion were trained to carry on the
traditions of their fathers, the Torah
would soon be forgotten. He told
them that their very life depended
on the observing of the law "because
it is your life." The Rabbis so aptly
called the Torah "Nishmasam
Yisroel"—the very soul of the
Children of Israel.

How appropriate it is that these
words should be read on Shabos
Sh'oovah, when every Jew during
these Ten Days of Penitence reflects
on his actions and seeks ways and
means of implanting the true Jew-
ish spirit within the heart of the
younger generation. It is this spirit
which has helped the Jew through-
out the ages to preserve his identity.

Mr. Morris Hillquit was elected
last night Chairman of the Social-
ist Party of America in succession
to the late Victor Berger, who was
also a Jew. The election coincided
with Mr. Hillquit's 60th birthday
and he was given a dinner in
honour of the occasion. Messages
from Mr. Philip Snowden and other
members of the British Government
congratulating him on his election
were read out at the dinner.

Mr. Hillquit was born in Riga.
He was educated at the New York
Law School and was admitted to
the Bar in 1893. He has written
a number of books on Socialism.
In 1917 he stood as Socialist can-
didate for Mayor of New York,
polling 145,000 votes.
