The main feature of the evening was the screening of a Russian film, originally produced by the Moscow Art Theatre, entitled "A Daughter's Temptation." The main characters in the story are Suboff, a waiter, and his beautiful daughter Natalie, who is symbolic of the strength of virtue against vice. The period of the story is that of the Great War. The acting was very good and the film, on the whole, a most enjoyable one.

At the opening of each part of the programme Herr August Grader conducted an Overture by Reissiger and a selection of Russian national airs respectively, the orchestra being drawn from members of the Cape Musicians' Association. During the screening of the film Mr. Hancock directed the music. Songs during the evening were rendered by Miss Margaret Wandelt and Mr. John Clinto, Mrs. Ellie Marx accompanying the singers. She also led the orchestra.
