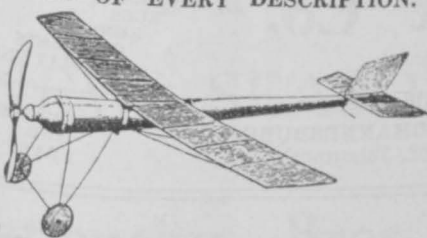
### TREISMAN—FITTINGHOFF.
