Benno Moiseiwitsch at the City Hall.

The playing of Benno Mosseiwitsch was so outstandingly beautiful at his first concert given at the City Hall, last Tuesday evening, that the large audience was roused to a glow of enthusiasm seldom experienced in this town. There is a breadth of dignity in the playing of this "Musical Messiah." With the tremendous technical resources that he has at his command, he succeeded in giving his listeners thrills of ecstasy as he warmed their hearts with beautiful harmonies and brilliant melody.

In his calm, beautiful rendering of the Appassionata Sonata by Beethoven, Moiseiwitsch emphasised the deep passionate notes that sounded ceaselessly throughout the first movement, and brought all his art into play in the immense vitality of the *Finale*. In this work as in Beethoven's *Andante Favori*, the performer proved himself a master of light and shade.

He gave five pieces of Chopin, where his balanced phrases and brilliancy of interpretation were in evidence to the joy of his audience. His playing of the *Waltz in E Minor* was a revelation in interpretive beauty.

His fine shading and technical sureness were fully displayed in *Isolden's Liebestod* and *Tannhauser Overture* by Wagner-Liszt, both works being received by the audience with delight.

A *Liszt Rhapsody* was one of the encores and the listeners could have sat through the entire programme again without tiring.

The second concert will take place to-night and will be attended by their Excellencies, the Governor-General and Countess Clarendon.

A third and final concert will be held on Monday, May 4th.
