

Now this final step has been achieved, and a Women's Zionist Council of South Africa has come into being. It is to be composed of representatives of the S.A. Zionist Federation on the one hand and of Women's Zionist Societies on the other, and will function as a branch or department of the S.A. Zionist Federation. The Council will have a wide field of work before it. It will aim not only at strengthening the Zionist movement among the Jewish women in all parts of the Union, but generally at co-ordinating women's work for all purposes, and at creating uniformity in women's Zionist work.

The formation of this new Council should undoubtedly provide a strong stimulus to women's Zionist activity in this country. Many questions of detail, and various aspects of the relationship between

the Council and the Wizo still remain to be settled. But the women have now an authoritative and centralised body of their own to preside over their special destinies, and the women's work should grow from strength to strength.

### Our Heifetz.

ARE we presumptuous when, in welcoming in our midst Jascha Heifetz, one of the world's greatest executants on the violin, the idol of a dozen countries, we greet him as *our Heifetz*? We know that genius is international, that the great artist belongs to the world. But does he not also belong to the people from whose blood he has sprung? However mysterious and elusive may be that "something" which makes the artist at once child of his people and citizen of the world,

it is real and actual; and Jascha Heifetz is *our Heifetz*.

But he is ours also in a nearer and more intimate sense — he shares our hopes and anxieties, our sufferings and our aspirations. The dream of Israel rejuvenated has seized his imagination, and not only has he twice gone up to Eretz Israel to see and to hear for himself, but he has not come empty-handed. He has brought into being a fund for the encouragement of musical talent among the Jews of the land. His last visit to Eretz Israel, which took place not many months ago, showed both his kinship in spirit with his people and their love for him. It was a sheer triumph; Heifetz drew inspiration from Eretz Israel, and Eretz Israel drew inspiration from Heifetz.

We bid hearty welcome to our Jascha Heifetz — Jew and world-renowned artist.
