### Opening of Reform Temple

Ceremony to Take Place on Sunday  
Afternoon.

The inaugural service of Temple Israel—the first Reform Synagogue in South Africa—will take place at the synagogue, corner Paul Nel and Claim Streets, Johannesburg (off Clarendon Circle) on Sunday, August 23, at 3 p.m. The service will be conducted by the minister, Rabbi Moses C. Weiler.

The Hon. Mr. J. H. Hofmeyr (Minister of the Interior) and Councillor Maldwyn Edmund (Mayor of Johannesburg) have signified their intention of being present at the ceremony.

### Success of South African Chalutz

It is interesting to learn that Mr. Morris Shapiro, who left South Africa three years ago as a Chalutz, has been sent by the Palestinian Government (agricultural department) to study certain aspects of stock farming under Professor L. Adowetz, of Czecho-Slovakia, who is famous as a world authority on this subject.

The Palestinian Agricultural Department has employed Mr. Shapiro in the capacity of a sheep and goat expert, and after his studies with Professor Adowetz, Mr. Shapiro, who is accompanied by his newly-wedded wife, will visit different countries to secure special breeding stock, as well as for the purpose of recommending to the department different types of goats suitable for Palestine.

### "The Progress of Zionism"

The third and revised edition has appeared of the pamphlet "The Progress of Zionism," by the well known Jewish publicist, Israel Cohen. In concise form an authoritative account is given of the salient features of the Zionist programme and achievements. ### The Transvaal Zionist Youth Executive

GOOD PROGRESS OF LIBRARY  
CAMPAIGN.

Good progress has been made during the past week in the library campaign of the Transvaal Zionist Youth Executive. A large number of members of the Youth Organisation canvassed certain suburbs in Johannesburg on Sunday, the 16th inst., and called on residents for donations of books or of money. The results of this "Book Day" effort showed about £50 in cash and a number of useful books.

This sum, in addition to funds previously collected, has provided the means to open the library within two or three weeks. Borrowing facilities will be available not only to members of the Youth, but also to the general public at a small deposit and a yearly subscription.

The committee in charge of the scheme intend continuing their campaign as vigorously as possible in Johannesburg, and are extending it to other towns in the near future. It is hoped, with the support of the public, to establish an institution that will be of real value to the whole of Transvaal Jewry.

The executive wish to take this opportunity of expressing their thanks to the public, to the willing band of workers, and especially to the Central Districts Zionist Youth Society, who brought in the largest sum collected on "Library Day."
