

To-day there was a tremendous reaction in the world against liberty and toleration. The Jews needed more Judaism as a protection against anti-Semitism. If the Jew became a hybrid product, neither Jew nor Gentile, he would be all the more despised. Jews must have their own country not only as a refuge for the individual Jew but as a centre for the Jewish spirit, a place where the Jewish genius could find expression.

Mr. A. Geffen, Hon. Secretary of the Stellenbosch Hebrew Congregation, pro-posed a hearty vote of thanks to Rabbi and Mrs. Abrahams, which was carried with acclamation.
