Mrs. Mina Levitan, the convener, is most enthusiastic about the programme which promises to be delightfully entertaining and interesting. Among the artists who are kindly offering of their talent are Mr. Harold Hart, the very popular tenor, Miss Joyce Kadish, the well-known pianiste, Mr. Charles Kreitzer, the brilliant violinist, Miss Rita Maas, who as an impersonator is most outstanding, and Mr. Samuel Morris who has delighted many audiences with his fine singing. Mr. Walter Swanson will conduct the orchestra, and there will be dancing by students of the Elvira Kirsch Studio of Dancing. Miss Hilda Schwalbe is acting as accompanist.

A Barmitzvah Celebration.

Leon, youngest son of Dr. and Mrs. C. Resnekov read a Portion of the Law and Maftir at the Gardens Synagogue on Saturday, March 29th.

A reception in honour of the occasion was held at the Zionist Hall on Sunday afternoon. Rev. S. Kassel was in the chair.

Rabbi I. Abrahams proposed the toast of the Barmitzvah and Rabbi M. Ch. Mirvish that of the parents.

Mr. H. M. Bloch spoke on behalf of the Dorshei Zion Association and announced that the Committee were inscribing the name of the Barmitzvah in the Sefer Habarmitzvah.

Dr. I. M. Hurwitz spoke on behalf of the Cape Board of Jewish Education (of which Dr. Resnekov is chairman) and presented the Barmitzvah with a set of the Massadah Encyclopaedia in Hebrew.

Dr. A. Birnbaum, Director of the Cape Board of Jewish education, spoke in Hebrew and presented the Barmitzvah with the certificate of the Board of Jewish Education.

Mr. A. Sive spoke on behalf of the Hebrew Teachers' Association.

Rev. Kassel announced that the Woodstock-Salt River Talmud Torah were planting six trees in Palestine in the name of the Barmitzvah, and the Woodstock-Salt River Branch of the Bnoth Zion Association, five trees.

The Barmitzvah responded in Hebrew and English.

Dr. C. Resnekov responding, paid a tribute to his sons' Hebrew teacher, Mr. Lederman (a grandson of Dr. Hermann Shapiro) and announced that in appreciation of his work, he and Mrs. Resnekov were inscribing his name in the Golden Book.

During the course of the afternoon Mr. Boris Rome rendered several Yiddish songs which were very much appreciated.
