

Zionist Youth Activities.

Musical Evening.

Cecil Roth, writing about the Jewish contribution to civilisation, remarks that "their contribution has become interwoven inextricably with the common stock by a thousand different strands. Disintegrate this and the tree of Western culture would be mutilated." The reality of that contention was well illustrated by Mr. Hans Kramer at a musical evening organised by the Hapoel Hamizrachi and the Observatory-Mowbray Zionist Youth Society on behalf of the Cape Zionist Youth Executive. In a very interesting lecture, ably interspersed and illustrated by recordings, Mr. Kramer traced the Jewish contribution to music. He showed how the church music often got its inspiration from Jewish tunes in the synagogue and how in classical music the Jews played a most prominent part as composers, pianists, cellists, singers, conductors, and especially violinists. Among scores of Jewish names which Mr. Kramer mentioned were the most famous musicians. The gramophone records, which helped to illustrate Mr. Kramer's interesting lecture, was also directly connected with Jewish genius. Emil Berliner was the first man who improved upon Edison's cylindrical gramophone records by inventing the flat disc.

The musical evening proved to be an outstanding success. Mr. Egert, in proposing a vote of thanks, expressed the hope that with the Jewish renaissance in Palestine there would also be a revival in Jewish music and the unrecorded tunes of ancient days would again re-echo in the fields of modern Eretz Israel.

Worcester Zionist Youth Rally.

During Sunday and Monday took place one of the most successful rallies that the Zionist Youth in the Western Province ever had. Delegates left Cape Town on Saturday evening and when they arrived a little before midnight at Worcester they were very ably accommodated by the Worcester Zionist Society and were most hospitably received by the Worcester community. The whole of Sunday was devoted to cultural work. On Sunday morning Mr. David Lurie, Chairman of the Worcester Zionist Youth Society welcomed the delegates, who hailed from many centres, representing almost all societies in the Western Province. Mr. Egert replied on behalf of the delegates and the Zionist Youth Executive. During the morning and early afternoon discussion took place on the organisation of the Western Province Zionist Youth. Mr. Cohen introduced a discussion on organisation. Mr. Shrand spoke on the position of the Menorah and Mr. Egert, in the absence of other conveners, spoke on Keren Hayesod, the Loan Membership Scheme, Junior Societies and Education. A lively discussion took place on Junior Societies and Education. Late on Sunday afternoon a debate took place, the motion being "That practical achievements in Palestine are more important than political activity in the realisation of Zionist aims." Messrs. B. Melmed and H. Shandling spoke for the motion and Messrs. Cohen and Egert spoke against it. The motion was carried by an overwhelming majority. Mr. Michael Shochat was in the chair during the debate. On Sunday evening there was an "At Home" during which a play was presented by Mr. Shrand and solo songs were rendered by the Misses Hilda Abrahams and Mona Pirutin. Monday morning was devoted to an enjoyable picnic at De Wet. The rally closed officially at 1 o'clock.

Mr. Lurie, in bidding farewell to delegates, mentioned the gratitude that was due to Mr. Michael Shochat and Miss Fanny Zackon for the hard work they had put in to make the rally an outstanding success. Some further details of the discussion on Sunday will be published in a forthcoming issue.

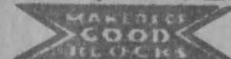
