Georges Themeli.

The Greek pianist Georges Théméli, blind since birth, started playing the piano when he was three years old. He studied first in Cairo, then in Paris at the National Conservatoire. He gave his first recital at the age of 10 and played as soloist Grieg's piano concerto with orchestra when he was 13 years old. He was the first blind pianist to be admitted at the Conservatoire de Paris and in 1936 won the first prize, being the only blind candidate and yet, as critics said, "the most talented king" of the competition. Engaged as soloist by the great symphonic orchestras of Europe, he began a brilliant career and got the most praise from the most severe critics. Since then Georges Théméli has known numberless triumphs in Europe as well as in Egypt, Palestine and Syria.

Théméli received a warmly appreciative hearing at the Metro Theatre, Johannesburg, on November 11th. He will give a recital at the City Hall, Cape Town, on December 12th and at the Muizenberg Pavilion on December 13th.
