

Zionist Youth Activities.

An interesting and lively Oneg Shabbat took the form of a Brains Trust on Sunday night, 10th May. Mr. C. K. Friedlander was the question-master and the team further consisted of Mr. R. B. Egert, Mr. A. Berezowski, Mr. E. Kluk and Mr. D. Sadowsky. Mr. Friedlander announced at the beginning of the proceedings that he thought, as his audience was going to go through the hazardous experience of a Youth Conference in a day's time, the evening should be devoted to the discussion of humorous or semi-humorous questions and not to the discussion of serious Zionist topics. During the evening Miss Ray Kantor and Mr. Herzl Konvisser rendered a few songs. The final talk in the series by Sybil Berman on "What is Zionism?" was given in conclusion.

On Sunday, 5th May, the Society held a meeting at the residence of Miss Shirley Futerman. Miss Ruth Blumberg gave a talk on Communal Settlements. The audience was well enlightened by the end of her discussion. Next followed a talk on the Keren Hayesod by Mary Friedman and a summary of the Anglo-American Inquiry Commission by Frank Silbert, after which a piano solo was rendered

by Shirley Futerman. The meeting ended with some song solos and a sing-song directed by Mike Peck.

A General Meeting of the **Worcester Junior Zionist Society** was held on 20th April in the Zionist Hall, which was packed to capacity. There was a record attendance of 45 members present.
