## Solomon—Celebrated Pianist.

Solomon, the famous celebrity pianist, who is to give a recital at the City Hall on November 1st, was born in London and first appeared in public at the age of eight at an orchestral concert in the Queens Hall. He attained enormous popularity as a prodigy and before he was twelve years old he had no less than fourteen concertos in his repertoire and several recital programmes. His orchestral engagements at that time included concerts with some of the world's greatest conductors, Arthur Nikisch, Sir George Henschel, Sir Henry Wood, Sir Hamilton Harty, Sir Landon Ronald and others, while in recent years it would be superfluous to mention that he has played with many more.

At the age of fifteen he wisely retired from the public eye, and it is partly due to this fact that we may attribute his subsequent success as a mature artist. He spent a few years in Paris, where he studied the piano under Levi and theory under Marcel Dupre, the famous organist of Notre Dame. He made his reappearance in London some five years later when he proved himself one of those rare instances of a prodigy unspoiled by early triumphs, and is now accepted as one of the greatest living masters of his instrument.
