

75,000 Jews Given Palestinian Status.

TEST CASE ON ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS.

Jerusalem.

Residential status and the right to apply for citizenship were given to approximately 75,000 illegal immigrants in Palestine on Tuesday as a result of a test case decision of the Palestine Supreme Court.

Those affected by the decision have, since their entry into Palestine, remained without legal recognition. Some arrived secretly without proper papers while others entered with visitors' visas and remained when these had expired.

Deportation orders were made out in most cases but were not enforced because of the war and for other reasons.

The Palestine Government, however, made a practice of cancelling one immigration certificate for each illegal immigrant, but had hitherto refused to recognise the legal status of such persons in Palestine.

This resulted in many illegal immigrants losing their nationality since they were unable to return to their native lands to obtain Palestine visas on their passports.

Outstanding American Scientist to do Research at Daniel Sieff Institute

Dr. Milton Orchin of Pittsburgh, Head of the Organic Section of the Synthetic Liquid Fuels Programme of the American Bureau of Mines, has arrived in Palestine to carry out organic chemistry at the Daniel Sieff Institute at Rehovoth. He was awarded a Guggenheim Foundation Memorial Fellowship for outstanding scientific work. He selected the Sieff Institute from the most prominent institutions available to him such as Harvard and others.

Jewish Watchman Killed in Dagania.

It is officially announced that a watchman, Ruven Schneiderman (23), was killed and another watchman, Yehoshua Zerim, seriously injured while guarding the Dagania fishpond on 9th October at midnight, when they were fired on by unknown assailants.

J.N.F. Month.

"A PROPHECY FULFILLED."

The highlight of the Jewish National Fund Month will be a concert which is due to take place at the Zionist Hall on 9th November. The play is being produced by Mrs. Freda Rubinstein. The concert will consist of 10 scenes and the large cast will be made up of the various sections of the Zionist Youth Movement, including the 1946 returned Post-Matriculants. The theme of the concert is the prophecy of Jeremiah that land would once more be bought in Eretz Israel.

In response to a request by the J.N.F. Executive many societies have already accepted the suggestion to arrange special J.N.F. meetings during the month. Details of these meetings will appear in the special J.N.F. supplement to the "Jewish Chronicle." On Sunday morning, 19th October, the Annual Conference of the Jewish National Fund Council will take place at the Zionist Hall.

Palestine Industrial Exhibition.

New sources of supply of manufactured goods, particularly within the sterling area, are being sought by the South African commercial community. It is therefore only natural that local businessmen should look forward with keen interest to the First Palestine Industrial Exhibition to be held in Johannesburg early next month.

The South African Board for Inter-Trade Relations with Palestine, which is sponsoring the Palestine Industrial Exhibition, is busy completing all arrangements. The Johannesburg Chamber of Commerce has been contacted and it is anticipated that every member of the Chamber will visit the exhibition. The exhibits, packed in 45 cases, are expected to reach Johannesburg this week-end. A team of experts is co-operating with the Board in the necessary technical preparations. The major hall of the Coronation Hall, where the exhibition will be held, is being specially renovated for the occasion. Mr. Herzl Zuckerman, the Representative of the Foreign Trade Institute in Palestine and the Palestine Manufacturers' Association, has received a large consignment of sample goods and is contacting numerous business firms.

The steady exodus of Rumanian Jews from Vienna to Italy and the U.S. zone of Germany continues at the rate of 1,200 weekly. Since new arrivals from Rumania now total only about half that number, it is expected that, barring unforeseen events, the Jewish refugees population in Austria will be down to 20,000 by winter.
