## Plans to Meet Emergency Situation in Palestine.

### MEETING IN JOHANNESBURG.

A meeting fully representative of Johannesburg Jewry took place under the auspices of the South African Zionist Federation at the Carlton Hotel, on Wednesday afternoon of last week, to discuss the emergency position which has been created in Palestine following the decision of U.N.O. to grant Jewish Statehood.

The extent to which South African Jewry can be relied upon to play its role in the present urgent situation was fully discussed and preliminary plans were made to launch a fund-raising campaign to meet the emergency situation.

### MISS RAYE LEVIN.

The death took place on Monday of Miss Raye Levin, the well-known Cape Town pianist. She had been in poor health for three years and underwent an operation on Saturday.

Miss Levin formed the first all-women's orchestra in Cape Town and played the piano at Government House and at Admiralty House, Simonstown, for private dances for the Prince of Wales.

She organised music for the Good Cheer Club and for many other war efforts and did a vast amount of organisation for war funds.

### Desecration of the Sabbath.

The Editor,  
"S.A. Jewish Chronicle."

Sir,  
As a young Jewish immigrant who has just arrived here from London, let me say how much I admired the stand taken by your columnist "Hasofer" against the organised desecration of the Sabbath by Jewish bodies. I do not propose to compare the standards of Jewish observance in this country with those in England, although that would prove very interesting. But I have noticed that, contrary to the practice in England, non-observant Jews here seem to have absolutely no regard for the feeling of their more observant brethren. A glaring and shocking example is the parking of cars near the Synagogues on Sabbath. Never in many years of regular "shul" going in England have I ever seen a worshipper's car parked anywhere near an orthodox Synagogue on the Sabbath. Not that many English Jews would be averse to riding on the Sabbath, but they would have sufficient self-respect and consideration for the feelings of their fellow worshippers to leave their cars at home when going to the Synagogue. It is a matter of ordinary common decency to do so surely, and for my own part I was severely shocked and very hurt indeed by what I felt to be the gratuitous insult flung in my face by my fellow worshippers driving up in their cars to the very doors of the Synagogue. After two or three weeks of this, I have determined to seek out a Synagogue where my feelings would not thus be outraged, and I am sure that were similarly-minded Jews to do likewise this particular abuse would decline and possibly die out altogether.

South African Jews are surely no less considerate than English Jews!
