Esther Salaman and Paul Difficulties Between Hamburger.

JOINT RECITAL TOMORROW NIGHT.

Esther Salaman, mezzo-soprano, and Paul Hamburger, pianist, the two artists who arrived in the Union last month from England on a broadcasting tour, will give a joint recital in the City Hall to-morrow (Saturday) night.

Esther Salaman, who is a daughter of Dr. Redcliffe Salaman, the well-known scientist and Zionist, and of Nina Salaman, the Anglo-Jewish

writer, was a pupil of Elena Gerhardt, Alfred Piccaver and Wolfsohn. She has broadcast many recitals on the home service of the B.B.C., including groups of songs in the Children's Hour with the explanations spoken by herself, and has also appeared on television. She has given solo recitals in London and the provincial towns, and sings for the Arts Council of Great Britain and the British Council, the London County Council and the United Nations Organisation.

Throughout the war Esther Salaman sang for the forces all over the British Isles, and particularly for the bombed and homeless, in air-raid shelters and rest-centres. Under the auspices of the rest-centres. Under the auspices of the British Council she organised community singing with nine different nationalities—adults and children—resident in England during the war.

Paul Hamburger (her husband) was a British Council scholar at the Royal College of Music under Frank Merrick and later under Franz Osborn. As a concert pianist he has performed

and later under Franz Osborn. As a concert pianist he has performed throughout the British Isles, largely under the auspices of the Arts Council of Great Britain. Apart from solo work, he has specialised in chamber music and also accompaniments. He has often broadcast.

In London Mr. Hamburger has won a name for himself for his original coaching in interpretation, particularly of more advanced musicians.

Miss Salaman's programme tomorrow night will include early Italian and early English songs, lieder by Schubert and Brahms, and folksongs, including Jewish songs.

Miss Salaman will be accompanied by Paul Hamburger, who will also play the Beethoven Piano Sonata in C major, opus 53 (Waldstein).

Revisionist Party and S.A. Zionist Federation.

STATEMENT BY FEDERATION.

Zionist Federation has The S.A. issued the following statement:

In view of the fact that the Revision-ist Party has chosen to publish letters passed between themselves and the Executive of the Zionist Federation in connection with the Jewish State Rally held in Johannesburg on 16th May, the Executive wishes to make known

the following facts:-

Difficulties have arisen between the Revisionist Party and the Executive of the Zionist Federation as a result of the Revisionist Party's decision to launch the 'Tron Fund Campaign' on behalf of the Irgun despite a specific ruling by the World Executive of the Zionist Organisation that no section of the Zionist movement may collect funds for this purpose. In view of this breach of Zionist discipline it had been decided to refer the question to the court of honour provided by the constitution of the Federation. When the question of the Jewish State Rally meeting was considered, the Chairman of the Zionist Federation, Mr. Gering, put it to the Revisionist delegate that if his party would at any time before Sunday's meeting agree to announce the abolition of the Revisionist Party's Iron Fund Campaign, there would be no objection to the Revisionist Party

having a speaker on the platform.

Unfortunately the Revisionist Party delegate was not prepared to give such an undertaking. Whatever the position was before the establishment of the Jewish State, it was hoped that appear the State, had been weekinged. of the Jewish State, it was hoped that once the State had been proclaimed, the Irgun would stand by their undertaking to disband. Under these circumstances it was hoped that the Revisionist Party would be prepared to make public an announcement before the Jewish State Rally took place, undertaking not to continue its separatist activities in this hour of supreme ratist activities in this hour of supreme need for one united effort. It would have placed the Zionist Federation in an impossible situation had it agreed to a Revisionist speaker appearing on the State Rally platform on Sunday, only to face continuation by the Revisionist Party of separatist activity on Monday. Monday. The present situation, as never before, calls for the closing of the ranks of Jewry throughout the world behind the one command and one authority. There is no possible room left for dissident action within the Jewish State and within the World Zionist Organisation.
