South African tour with a noble
gesture to stricken Holland where she
had found hospitality and friendship.On Sunday night she displayed her
generosity once again by giving a per-
formance in aid of three institutions
in Palestine, where she had made her
home. The Palestine Orchestra and
the two Hebrew theatres will benefit
considerably from the proceeds of the
well attended concert.An enthusiastic audience welcomed
the gracious white-clad youthful
artiste as she mounted the stage. She
opened her programme with the
gently flowing Adagio Favari of
Mozart. Her control of the pianis-
simo parts was particularly good.Schumann's Carnival followed, and
Miss Goldstein proved equal to the
technical intricacies and interpreta-
tive variability of this great work.
She rendered the various changes of
mood in each picture convincingly and
with sureness. Chopin's Polonaise
brillante and Faure's Impromptu No. 3
gave the pianist an opportunity to
display her versatility. De Bussey's
Clair de Lune was played with all the
mystery and gentleness of moonlight
flowing out of the pianist's exquisite
touch.The triumph of the evening was
three movements of Stravinsky's Pe-
trouchka arranged for the piano. She
seemed to experience every bit of the
musical carnival which she performed
with vigour, clarity and sensitivity.
In response to persistent applause
Miss Goldstein gave three encore
the most delightful and popular of
which was La Campanella by Liszt.
